Foreign Affairs Police

Foreign affairs police are in charge of the protection of foreign population (including foreign nationals, people of Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macao residents, and R.O.C. nationals without Taiwanese household registration), foreign missions and institutions along with their officials in Taiwan, the handling of cases involving foreign nationals and the cooperation with the international police units. As international exchange activities, and the trend of fast population movement are on the rise, human trafficking for sexual exploitation, and labor exploitation has been posing a threat to human rights and public order. Therefore, proactive crackdown on human trafficking has become one of the main tasks for the foreign affairs police.
